Browser

For the best experience, we recommend using the system on browsers such as Firefox, Chrome, Edge, or Opera.
Always make sure to close and restart your browser before accessing the system again, as this helps ensure efficiency.
Make sure that both your browser and your computer are updated and running the correct version.

Clearing browsing data is important because:

-  **Updates load correctly** – Old cached files may prevent the system from showing the latest version.
-  **Improves performance** – Removing unnecessary stored data can make the browser run faster.
-  **Protects privacy** – Deleting cookies and history reduces stored personal information.
-  **Fixes errors** – Corrupted cache or outdated cookies can cause login or display issues.

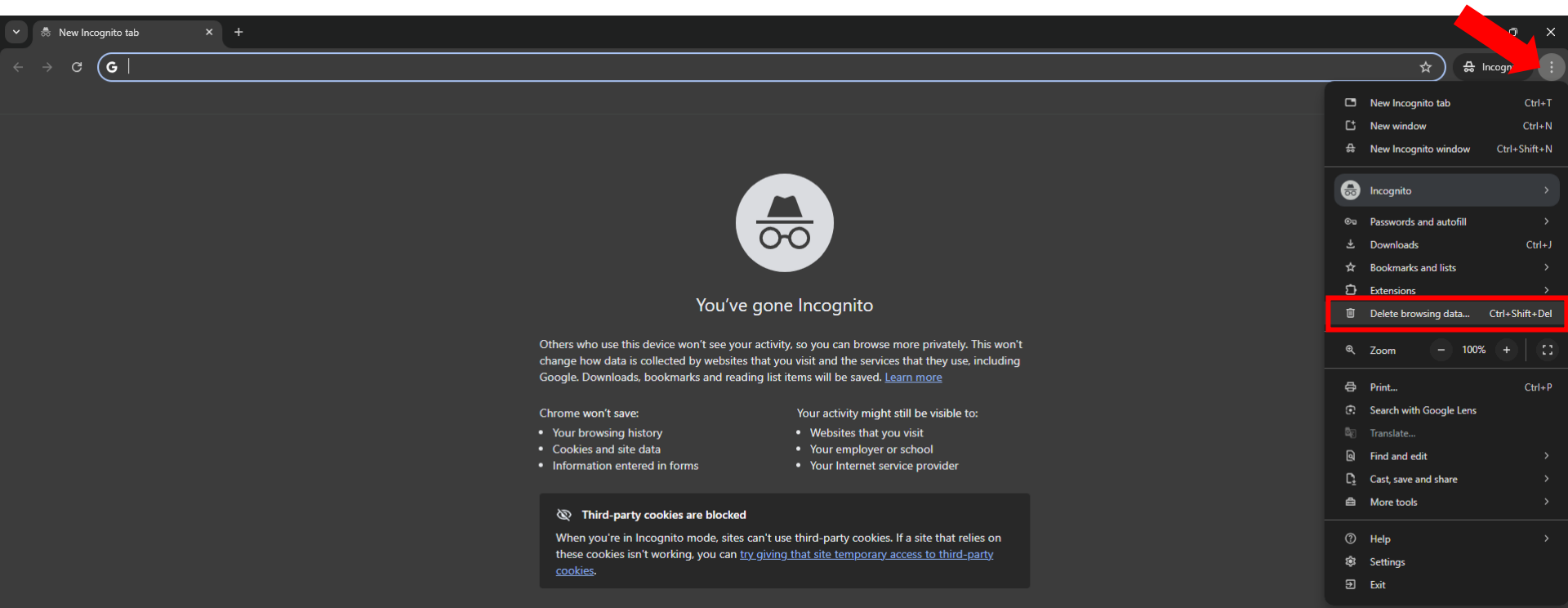

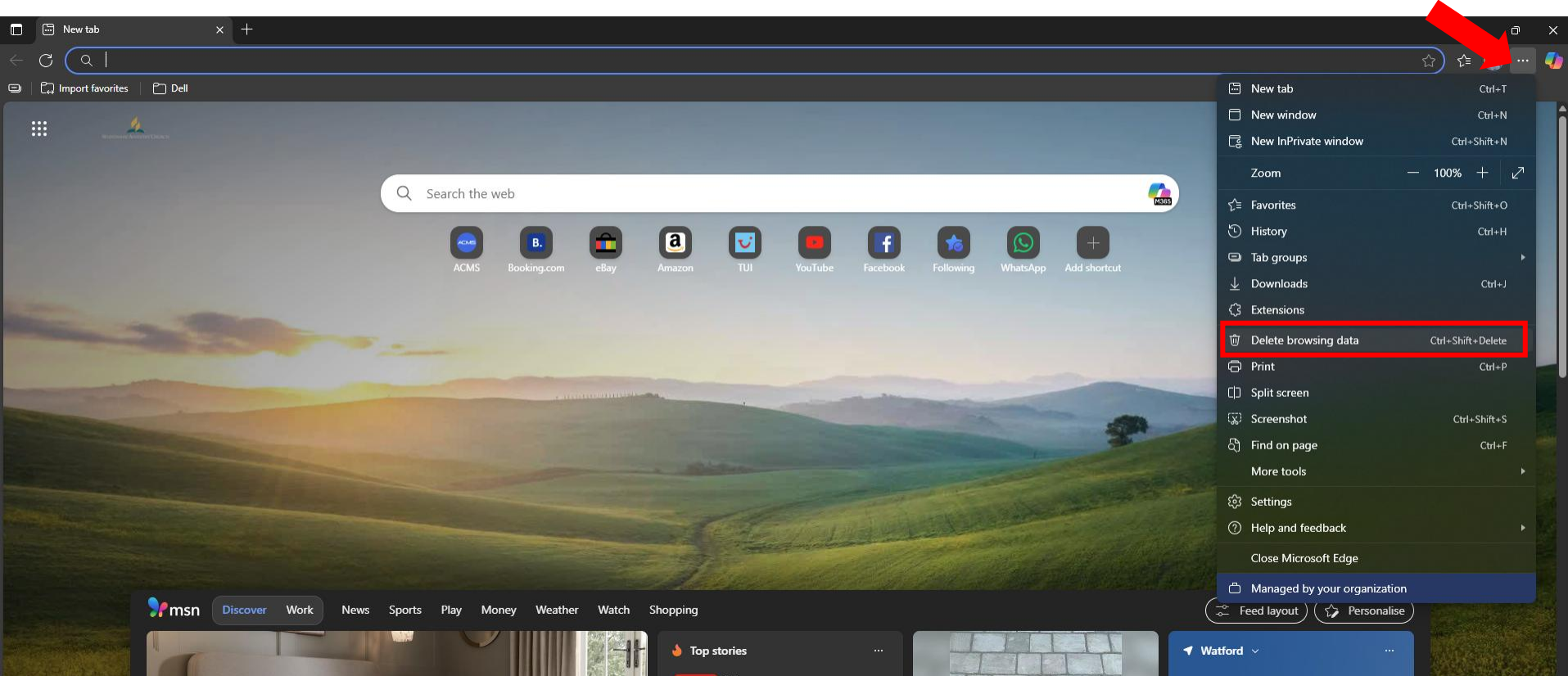
